Big Idea of Surah Fatiha: Faith, life and the afterlife

- Names of the Surah: Fatiha, Ummul Kitab, Mathani, Salat
- Ayat: 7
- Virtues: لا صلاة لمن لم يقرأ بفاتحة الكتاب
- [All] praise is [due] to Allah, Lord of the worlds
 - o no extra emphasis added
- The Entirely Merciful, the Especially Merciful
 - o Difference, implications, ocean v. lake
- Sovereign of the Day of Recompense
 - o Micro v. Macro
- It is You we worship and You we ask for help
 - o Present: statement
 - o Future: a promise/contract
- Guide us to the straight path
 - o Individual v. communal
 - Individual: personal/emotional, direction in life/midlife crisis, parents, spouse, kids
 - Communal: gender (men v. women), governance (individual freedoms v. authority), economics (pursuit of profit v. ethics/morality)
- The path of those upon whom You have bestowed favor

• not of those who have evoked [Your] anger or of those who are astray. (7)

- a guidance
- Types of people
 - o for those conscious of Allah
 - Their properties?

 - Those are <u>upon</u> [right] guidance
 - o Every disbeliever?
 - Hypocrisy = being two-faced
 - Two examples to demonstrate their nature: biggest losers, scared of the Shariah

- It is He who created for you all of that which is on the earth
- The beginning of leadership: Adam [AS]
