- Those who are prevented from benefiting from the Qur’an (45-)
- The sweetness of the Qur’an is felt in prayer, especially fajr (78-82)
- The greatness of the Qur’an (88-89)
- It’s the truth (105-106)
- Attitude of those who were given knowledge upon hearing the recitation (107-109)

BIG IDEA OF SURAH KAHF: TRIALS AND TRIBULATION OF LIFE

- Begins with Qur’an and ends with Qur’an (i.e. to make it out of the trials and tribulations of life the Qur’an is essential)
- Trials:
 - Following the true religion
 - Having money and luxury
 - Day of Judgement
 - Knowledge and status (Iblees and Musa, contrasting examples)
 - Authority and power (Dhul Qarnayn)
